

EPO PORTAL MIGRATION

Michel has migrated the SAS Portal 1 to SAS Portal 2. SAS Portal 1 was running under LDAP and SAS Portal 2 is using the SAS 9 Metadata Server on MVS and channel storage on AIX.

Michel has created a common public kiosk which is available for everybody in the EPO. All (around 4000) examiners can access the public kiosk. Some links to information pages and pulled reports are added. With these pulled reports an user can run dynamically created reports.

In the public kiosk 10 pulled reports are defined. On the background SAS Code is running. For this dynamically created reports Michel developed a automatically SAS created jsp file filled with some parameters. The user can select the production unit, year and output format. After submitting the report, the user receives a package with the results of the parameterized selection.

Each pulled report has its own parameters.

Next to the pulled reports an user can log on the portal to get his own reports. An user is subscribed to a subscriber group which has access to one or more publication channels.

Batch processes create new users, groups and channels in the SAS 9 Metadata Server.

Each month batch processes create and publish around 15 reports to the 350 different channels.
